Mr. Raymond Robinson, Vice Chair, called the online Zoom meeting to order at approximately 6:06 p.m.

Dr. Guercio and Mr. Williams were excused for medical reasons.

A motion to approve the 05/28/24 Board meeting minutes was offered by Mr. Kottler and approved unanimously.

Opening remarks by the Chair:

Executive Director's Report:

Ms. Elizabeth Pittinger, Executive Director, informed the Board the intake is 107 complaints this year. Zone 2 produced the most complaints, 23. Zone 3 and Zone 1 each produced 19 complaints. Zone 5 produced 15 complaints, Zone 4 produced 11 complaints, and Zone 6 produced 8 complaints as of June 24th, 2024.

Ms. Pittinger introduced the Board's new solicitor, Mr. Alec Wright. Mr. Wright stated that he would be happy to answer any questions and was honored to be offered the position of solicitor to the Board. He noted that he requested and received ethics opinions, both professionally and governmentally, to ensure there would be no conflict between his private practice as an attorney and serving as solicitor for the Board. After much discussion with the Allegheny County Bar Association (ACAB) and The City of Pittsburgh Ethics Hearing Board, Mr. Wright is confident there will be no conflict. If such a dispute arises, he will take the necessary steps to resolve the issue.

Ms. Pittinger asked if the Board would agree on a date for the previously discussed Board Development Training Session. The Board collectively agreed to Thursday, July 18th, 2024, 6:00 p.m.

Case Review:

Mr. Kottler had a question regarding case #058-24; he stated that no video footage was found, but the police activated the lights on their car; how come that footage has not been shown? Investigator Ellwood noted that he was still in the process of requesting documents from the Bureau and that he could get more information once the case went to a full investigation.

Mr. Davis had a question regarding case #014-24 ED and 012-24 being authorized as a suspension rather than a 30-day extension. Mrs. Hampton, Assistant Executive Director, let him know that these cases had already been through a 30-day extension and that additional time would be needed to gather evidence/ information. Ms. Pittinger further explained why these cases go to Suspension.

Mr. Kottler had a question regarding case #012-24 and wanted to know what was preventing this case from moving forward. Investigator Edwards stated that she is waiting for additional information from the Bureau. Ms Pittinger further explained that investigator Edwards was waiting to find out if a report had been filed for this particular incident. As this information could fall under CHRIA, receiving updates could take a little longer.

Mr. Robinson wanted clarification regarding what exactly happens with the Suspended cases while Investigators wait for the additional information. Ms. Pittinger stated that these cases stay in Suspension until the necessary tasks are completed or evidence is gathered for the investigator to bring it back to the Board for a disposition.

Mr. Robinson also asked whether the staff stays in communication with the complainants. Ms. Pittinger stated that staff does keep in contact with the complainants so they are aware that their case is still being looked at and that the staff is still willing to help in any way they can. Ms. Pittinger also applauded the Office of

Community Health and Safety for being a supportive resource for some complainants who may not have been able to receive help from the Board but could benefit from the help of OCHS and their resources.
